Ississippi's duck season lasts 60 days, but according to Ramsey Russell, it's always duck season. His GetDucks com claims, "It's Duck Season Somewhere." That is, somewhere among a long and growing list of world-wide destinations.

Russell's travel business has been enhanced by the internet. His agency stands out when compared to online competitors.


