ARGENTINA DUCK HUNT CHECKLIST

Important: Travel cancellation insurance strongly advised. Pre-trip questionnaires, forms, waivers and hunt fee balances for each member of your party must be received by our office within 60 days of your travel dates to ensure necessary licensing and reservations.

SHOOTING GLASSES ARE RECOMMENDED. THEY PROTECT YOUR EYES FROM BRUSH, STRAY PELLETS AND, DEPENDING ON THE COLOR, CAN ENABLE YOU TO DETECT BIRDS QUICKLY. BRING EAR PLUGS OR MUFFS AND A QUALITY PAIR OF SHOOTING GLOVES ARE ALSO SUGGESTED.

HUNTING EQUIPMENT

- QUALITY SEMI-AUTO AND OVER-UNDER SHOTGUNS MAY BE RENTED AT THE LODGE.
- SHOTGUN 12 GAUGE FOR DUCK IS RECOMMENDED (20 GAUGE SHELLS ALSO AVAILABLE). WE STRONGLY SUGGEST RENTALS.
- HARD GUN CASE FOR AIR TRANSPORTATION REQUIRED, MUST BE LOCKED.
- SMALL FLASHLIGHT, EARPLUGS, EYE PROTECTION

HUNTING CLOTHING

Fall and winter occur April through September and temperatures range from 30 to 70 degrees. Prepare to dress in layers.

- SHOOTING GLOVES
- CAMOUFLAGED, NEUTRAL HUNTING JACKET
- RAIN GEAR AND/OR A HEAVY COAT FOR THE COOL MORNINGS
- CHEST WADERS (LIGHTWEIGHT BREATHABLES ARE USUALLY PERFECT)
- BROAD-BRIMMED CAMOUFLAGE HAT/CAP

OTHER

- SWEATER IF TRAVELING FROM APRIL THROUGH OCTOBER
- LIGHT WALKING SHOES
- CAMERA/FILM
- PERSONAL TOILETRIES, MEDICATION
- SMALL DENOMINATIONS OF US CURRENCY FOR TIPS AND MISCELLANEOUS
- VALID U.S. PASSPORT
- ELECTRICAL TYPE C ADAPTER FOR ELECTRICAL DEVICES
- CERTIFICATION OF REGISTRATION FOR PERSONAL EFFECTS TAKEN ABROAD (FORM 4457) IF BRINGING FIREARM
