¿HOW TO LEGALLY EXPORT

your sport-hunted trophy into the US?

Before you attempt to export a sport-hunted trophy, it is important that you and your outfitter or guide understand the permitting, port inspection, and clearance requirements of both Mexico and the United States.

Permits are required for the exportation of all animal species from Mexico. These permits provide a means to balance use and conservation of protected species. By complying with permit requirements, you help conserve protected animal species.

Generally, to export sport-hunted trophies from Mexico, you will need permits from SAGARHPA and SEMARNAT.

If the species you want to export is protected under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) you will also need a CITES permit and the PROFEPA authority's inspection from Mexico to export your trophy.

Just like with Mexico, the United States has laws governing the importation of your sport-hunted trophy. First and foremost, the United States will inspect all paperwork from your hunt to insure that all applicable laws in Mexico were followed.



THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR EXPORTATION AND IMPORTATION OF YOUR TROPHY:

- · Hunting contract
- Tag (hunting permit)
- SACARHPA form-Autorizacion de Aprovechamiento de UMA (Ranch Management Permit)
- CITES Certificate
- If you are hunting Big Horn Sheep, you

- will also need the plug in the horns with the applicable number
- If you choose to use a broker for your trophy, a notary letter giving your broker authorization to import your trophy with USFWS is required.

We encourage you and your hunting outfitter to contact us for guidance. Please be aware that if you conduct certain regulated activities without the appropriate permits, you risk seizure of the trophy and a fine.



IMPORT TO EUROPE

A licensed and registered TRACES broker with the proper authorization is required to import sport-hunted trophies from Mexico into Europe. You must ensure that you have all the permits and documents required for legal hunting in Mexico.
